

Keyword Searching

These activities offer opportunity to explore the process of determining keywords for database searching. Students will produce a descriptive narrative of a photograph and craft supporting keywords and brainstorm keywords to use with their research topic or question (or a topic provided during instruction).

Activity 1 • Photographs & Keywords

Photograph 1

Describe the photo: 15-20 words

Photograph 2

Describe the photo: 15-20 words

Select four (4) or more keywords.
