5 Tips for locating children's books.

1

Getting Started

Start with the library catalog. It provides information for titles located in Archer Library's collection. Keyword, title, and author searches are most common for children's book searches.

2

Too many results? Limit

If conducting a keyword or subject search, the number of results may be overwhelming. Take time to modify and/or limit your search results to the **MAIN Juvenile** collection.

3

Full Catalog Record

Review the full catalog record. It provides details about number of pages, subjects - including fiction or literature, genre or form (when available), and often a summary statement.

4

Content Cafe!

If the catalog record has a book cover image, click on it! Content Cafe includes supplementary information such as summary, author notes, excerpts, cover image, and **professional reviews**.

5

Call Number

Take time to write down the call number. Not only will it lead you to the book's location on the second floor, the first letters also identify if the title is fiction (P) or non-fiction (A-N and Q-Z).
