Research starters are short summaries and authoritative overviews of popular research and disciplinespecific topics. Information provided in a research starter may be an entry from an encyclopedia, credible resources curated by database editors, and reference databases. They are a starting point for more in-depth research on a topic and often help students determine if the topic selected is appropriate (Course Library Guide).
